Public voiced concerns over the cost, why meters were not discussed, and if the MRWS contribute to the cost, flooding of low lying properties if the system fails, How the sewers will effect zoning/setbacks, If homeowners are going to have a vote on the project, Are the State Parks included in new system, possibility of usage fee, If homeowner has a compatible tank will they receive a rebate, Each tank will be water tight and have a back flow check valve to prevent overflow, How long can the system be without power before it fails, How much does it cost to run a sewage pump, Who will pay to pump the tanks, Will financing be available to homeowners for the initial cost to hook up to sewer, Has the board considered a mandate on septic cleaning for current systems, How long before someone will come to each house to inspect current system, Concerns that project will move forward before all the answers are worked out.
